HIPAA Privacy Policy

The Lutheran Home shall ensure that a resident's confidential health information (also known as Protected Health Information, PHI) is protected from use or disclosure in violation of the HIPAA Privacy Rules or other applicable federal or state requirements. All Lutheran Home employees are responsible for protecting the confidentiality of the residents' PHI, which may be obtained, maintained, used, disclosed, heard, or viewed while carrying out their responsibilities on behalf of the Lutheran Home. A resident's PHI should not be discussed with those not entitled to such information. Generally, conversations regarding a resident's PHI should not take place in public areas. In a rare situation where discussion needs to take place in a non-private area, those engaging in the conversation should take care that others do not overhear such discussion. Unauthorized use or disclosure of PHI shall result in appropriate disciplinary action. Any potential breach of confidentiality should be promptly reported to a supervisor or the Corporate Compliance Officer.
